Legislature called to order for 67th session

Senate, House set committee assignments

Changes to the committee structure in the House and a rocky start on the Senate side of the rotunda marked the beginning of the 67th Legislature, which got underway January 11 with Sen. Bill Bradbury (D-Bandon) serving as Senate president and Rep. Larry Campbell (R-Eugene) continuing as House Speaker.

The House committee changes reduced the number of full standing committees to 10, from last session's 17, and transferred many of the functions of the former committees to subcommittees. The House Natural Resources Committee, for example, now has jurisdiction over areas formerly reserved to the House committees for Agriculture, Forestry and Natural Resources; Environment and Energy; and Water Policy through the subcommittees on Agriculture and Forestry; Environment and Energy; and Water.

More than the names have changed, however. House Natural Resources Committee Administrator Kathryn Van Natta explained that public hearings and work sessions on all pending legislation will take place only in the subcommittees — the full committee will meet only to vote on legislation passed out of subcommittee proceedings. The committee chair, Rep. Ray Baum (R-LaGrande), will retain control of the committee's agenda and will make all assignments to each respective subcommittee.

In the Senate, this session's committee structure parallels that of last session's, with separate committees for Agriculture and Natural Resources and Water Policy, but the overall number of committees has dropped to 13 from last session's 16.

This session also will see the debut of a Joint Committee on Ways and Means, under the direction of Sen. Cliff Trow (D-Corvallis) and Rep. John Minnis (R-Trout-

dale), who will serve as co-chairs. The committee will have a number of subcommittees, including one dealing specifically with Natural Resources. Coastal legislators with membership on Ways and Means this session include **Sen. Joan Dukes** (D-Svensen), who will serve on both the General Government and the Natural Resources subcommittees, and **Rep. Hedy Rijken** (D-Newport) and **Rep. Veral Tarno** (R-Cocquille) who will serve as advisory members to the General Government and the Transportation/Economic Development subcommittees, respectively.

Other appointments of coastal legislators include those of **Sen. Stan Bunn** (R-Newberg), who will serve on the Senate committees on Education and Trade and Economic Development; **Sen. Joan Dukes**, who will chair the Senate Transportation Committee and serve on the Senate Rules Committee and on the Senate Ethics, Elections and Campaign Finance Committee. Senate President **Sen. Bill Bradley** will serve on the Senate Trade and Economic Development Committee.

On the House side, **Rep. Tim Josi** (D-Bay City) will serve on the House Natural Resources Committee and on its Agriculture and Water subcommittees. **Rep. Hedy Rijken** will serve on the House Commerce Committee and on its Subcommittee on Business. **Rep. Jim Whitty** (D-Coos Bay) will serve as vice-chair on the House Education Committee and will also serve on the House Committee on Revenue and School Finance along with **Rep. Tony Federici** (D-St. Helens). **Rep. Veral Tarno** will serve on the House Judiciary Committee and on its Subcommittee on Crime and Corrections.

In other coastal news, coastal caucus members have scheduled their first meeting of the new session for Tuesday, January 26 at 7:00 a.m. The caucus will meet at JB's restaurant on the northeast corner of Liberty and Trade streets in Salem and will elect a caucus chair, consider recommendations for presentations and speakers for upcoming meetings, discuss coastal issues and take care of other organizational tasks. OCZMA/Sea Grant choose new fellow for 1993 session

Sean Brennan, a third-year law student at the University of Oregon School of Law, will serve as this year's Oregon Coastal Zone Management Association/Oregon State University Sea Grant Legislative Fellow. Brennan will work out of Sen. Joan Dukes' (D-Svensen) office for the duration of the session and will serve as a staff assistant to Sen. Dukes and to the members of the Coastal Caucus.

Brennan succeeds Mara Brown, the OCZMA/Sea Grant legislative fellow for the 1991 session, who is mid-way through her second year at the University of Oregon School of Law and who will intern this session with Jeannette Holman of the Legislative Counsel's Office.

Brennan brings to the job experience working with the legislatures of three states: Oregon, where he served as an intern with the House Water Policy Committee and the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee during the 1991 session; Washington, where he served as a researcher for the Joint Committee on Pension Policy during the 1988 session and interim; and his native Hawaii, where he worked as a researcher with the non-partisan Legislative Reference Bureau in 1986-87 and again as a law clerk during the summer of 1990. His legal studies have concentrated on the areas of environmental, natural resources and ocean and coastal law.

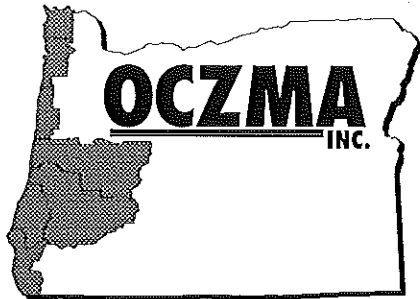
